McLeod County Back to School Drive 2010

For many parents and children, the thought of going back to school in the fall is not a pleasant one. Many dread the return because of the added pressure of not having the right clothes to wear, not having a nifty new hair cut, and not having all the required school supplies that are on the list. Common Cup Ministry, and the Salvation Army would like to make going back to school easier.



The goal for the Back to School Drive is to assure that all children in need, living in McLeod County, will return to school this fall with the basic supplies needed for the school year. Supplies will be distributed August 25, 5-8 p.m., and August 26, 9 a.m.-11:30 a.m.

How You Can Help

Salvation Army has purchased 400 backpacks. Our goal is to gather enough supplies to match or exceed the number of donated backpacks so each child can fill their backpack with the basic supplies needed. Below is a list of the basic school supplies needed. Purchase any of these supplies and drop them off in the church office or at Common Cup Ministry. Monetary donations are also accepted and will be used to purchase additional supplies. Every little bit helps!



Basic School Supplies Needed: #2 pencils, erasers, 4 oz bottles



of glue, glue sticks, pencil boxes & bags, plastic pocket folders, spiral notebooks, scissors (Fiskar), rulers, boxes of color markers, loose leaf paper, boxes of color pencils, highlighting markers, protractors, compasses, calculators, 3-ring binders, black fine line Sharpie markers, pencil sharpeners with covers, pens (black, red, blue), Prang water colors, 4-pack of dry erase markers, dictionaries, thesaurus' and backpacks.

Requesting School Supplies

Parents must request supplies for their children by using the official request form. Forms are available in the church office and the Common Cup office. Since only 400 children will be able to receive supplies, parents need to get their requests in as soon as possible.

The Institute of Lutheran Theology has opened a new online bookstore. The bookstore is what is known as an Amazon aStore. Amazon hosts the store, maintains the inventory, and handles all of the particulars of sales. ILT selects the types of products they wish to sell and promote the store.

The Institute has built the bookstore to serve two purposes according to Library Director, David Patterson: “First, it will facilitate access to the materials our students need to be successful in their studies. Second, it serves as a means for our constituents to support our efforts by purchasing Christian materials through us that they would purchase anyway.”

The products in the ILT store are similar to what you'd find in any Christian bookstore - including Christian books, magazines, ebooks, software, music, and videos. They will also be adding church supplies in the future as they have time to review the products to be added.

Currently, ILT is selling Amazon products, but as they continue to build their library collections and identify excess donated materials, they will begin to sell their own materials through Amazon. The Amazon products sold earn the Institute between 4% and 8% based on sales volume. All ILT proceeds from sales in our bookstore go to fund the library's collections and services in support of students, faculty, and constituents.
