The season of Lent is just around the corner. It begins on March 9 with Ash Wednesday. That day, there will be Holy Communion services at 12:00 p.m. and 6:30 p.m.

They will include the ancient tradition of marking our foreheads with ashes in the shape of the cross as a stark reminder that “we are dust and to dust we shall return.” That is the central truth of our human condition. It makes the promise of the Gospel vitally important, for it proclaims that Jesus has intervened to free us from death and raise us up to eternal life.

Each Wednesday from March 16 to April 13, there will be one service at 6:30 p.m. These Lenten services will be a little different this year, in an effort to bring the congregation together.

Our confirmation schedule has never meshed well with Lent. Classes usually finish around 5:30 p.m., which makes it hard for confirmants and their families to be back for worship at 6:30.

This year, we decided—only during Lent—to have confirmation meet at 6:30, too, instead of after school.

Confirmants, their parents and guides will join in Lenten worship, while continuing their year-long study of the Bible. The services will feature teaching sermons that continue that Bible survey, surrounded by worship that will include everyone who attends. A soup supper will be served in the Faith Center each week starting at 5:30 p.m.

The season of Lent is an ancient Christian practice designed to draw us deeper into the mystery of our salvation in Christ and help prepare us for the celebration of Holy Week and Easter. These forty days were set aside long ago to help Christians enter more deeply into the astounding gift of salvation which Christ Jesus won for us. Please join with other members of Faith this year as we combine Bible study and midweek worship during Lent.

Eligibility is household income that does not exceed federal poverty guidelines at 200% of poverty or a family identifying itself as "in crisis." Participating households self-identify; no proof of income or residence is requested.

**No cost to participants:** The host organization pays a fee per Food Outreach distribution to help offset costs for transportation and handling. There is no charge to receive the food.

### **Thrivent Members Can Now Designate "Choice Dollars" to Faith Lutheran Church**
