for a blessing.

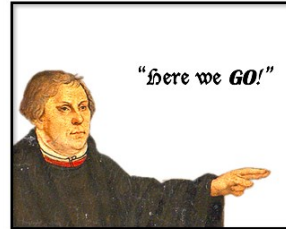
If you are unable to receive wine, please let the wine server know and
