
Beginnings: Markuz ul Bishara was established to train, and equip Christ-like leaders to engage and continue God's mission. By obeying the Great Commission of our Lord Jesus Christ, our team of leaders works in mission

fields bearing witness primarily to Muslims. Our ministries continue to expand and are spread across all states of India and beyond.

In 1979, Bishara's work began in a small one-room house rented at Manjeri in the State of Kerala, later expanding to its present status. Over the past 45 years the Lord has raised up many friends and well-wishers world-wide who support this ministry through their prayers and gifts. New Hope Mission Society has been one of these vital partners for nearly 25 of those years.

Bible College Moves the Witness Forward: The Shalliach Institute was given birth out of a convic-

tion that K.K. Alavi held deep within himself that the testimony of Jesus Christ is seriously jeopardized without new witnesses prepared to extend world evangeliza-



The program is Bible-based, Christ-centered, and ministry-oriented. It is our responsibility to preach the Gospel to our fellow Indians and preserve the faith and freedom of our children. SBC offers different programs to train and equip leaders. So far 150 students have graduated and are working in remote areas of our country. Many have started house churches in the villages and serve the community in multiple ways.

House Churches, Opportunities and Challenges

The settings are not glamorous and the challenges are great, but students trained at the Shaliach's Bible College are bearing powerful witness. In these pictures you see that, without pay or official titles the Good News of Jesus Christ is presented with many drawn to Christ through these humble witnesses. When a new family member comes to know Christ as their personal Lord and Savior, they reach out to other family members in their



villages to join in fellowship with them. Many of them become a part of this house church. These house churches typically range from 10 to 30 people. One special benefit of these house churches is that they help to break the caste system, bringing people together from different backgrounds and social classes.

Hindus and Muslims are predominant in India, and often may persecute family members who express any interest in Christ. The cost may be high, but the joy of being one with our gracious and merciful Savior keeps drawing many to face these challenges.







Literature Witness Continues

From the earliest days of Pastor K.K. Alavi's witness to Jesus Christ, sharing literature that lifts up the Good News of Jesus Christ has remained a major way to reach Muslims. Placing quotes from the Koran leads folk to read the literature and often to engage with students of the Bible College as they hand out these booklets and pamphlets. Our funds over the many years of this partnership provide for the printing of these material prepared by Pastor Alavi.

Festival Worship and Celebratory Meals Extend Witness

Pictured here is a recent Festival of the Resurrection worship service in which members of the local community were invited to the Bishara campus for worship. This provides an opportunity to have community members gather in a beautiful sanctuary to worship and hear the good news declared, that Jesus Christ is risen to be everyone's Lord and Savior!

Following this celebratory worship, the Bishara community and staff provide a festive meal for the community, a time for nurturing the body and building a loving community.


Stay Tuned - A Video-Taped Interview with Pastor K.K. Alavi Is Coming Soon
