
If you are unable to receive wine, please let the wine server know and grape juice will be provided. Gluten-free communion wafers are also available. Please let the server know and they will be provided.

The Seven Deadly Sins

Centuries ago, the Christian Church identified seven sins that pose particular danger to faith. Interestingly, all of them name desires that cause sin, not sinful actions as such. Building on our Lenten theme, we will explore the allure and damage of these deadly sins (Pride, Envy, Anger, Sloth, Covetousness, Gluttony and Lust) as illustrated by key Biblical accounts.
