What moves us to or away from a life of faith in God? Both heart and mind are central. This series will look primarily at heart issues.

The Seven Deadly Sins

Centuries ago, the Christian Church identified seven sins that pose particular danger to faith. Interestingly, all of them name desires that cause sin, not sinful actions as such. Building on our Lenten theme, we will explore the allure and damage of these deadly sins (Pride, Envy, Anger, Sloth, Covetousness, Gluttony and Lust) as illustrated by key Biblical accounts.
