Thursday, May 31 begins with potluck dinner at 12 noon. The program this month - Stump the Pastors. So please bring a friend, your questions, and we will see you there!



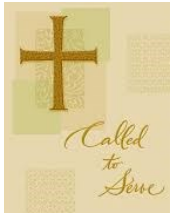
