### Congregational Meeting



At the congregational meeting last Wednesday, a large majority voted for "Option B" as the plan for using the bequest Faith Lutheran received from the estate of Delores Saar. That means the funds will be disbursed this way:

- \$45,000 (a tithe or 10%) will go to mission partners with building needs
- \$300,000 will be paid down on the current mortgage
- No money will be set aside for future needs
- \$25,000 will go into the endowment to fund mission projects in perpetuity
- \$8,000 will be used to maintain Faith's current buildings.

This large extra principal payment improves the chances that the entire mortgage can be paid by the time of Faith's 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 2020! Thanks to all those who attended and spoke at the special meeting. If you have any questions about it, contact Pastor Scott or Pastor Dave.

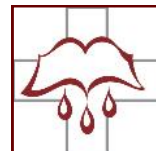
