

# Read your Bible in 2019!



ible reading plans are ready for you.

Chose the one you might be most attracted to use in 2019 for reading of Scripture.

#### #1—Cover-to-Cover

Read seven days per week for one year starting in Genesis and finishing in Revelation.

#### #2—Seven-day Cycle of Biblical Genres

This Bible Reading Plan features a rotating sequence of groupings—Epistles, Law, History, Psalms, Poetry, Prophecy, and Gospel.

#### #3—New Testament

The reading commitment is only one chapter per day for five days per week.

#### #4—App: Bible YouVersion

For the tek-savvy crowd, YouVersion provides many options on your Smart Phone or tablet.

#### #5—Beginner's Bible

(Children 3-years old - 2<sup>nd</sup> grade)

For children who have a "Beginner's Bible" there is a plan for parents to read one or two stories a week and then the children can put stickers on the board also.

#### #6—Hand's On Bible (Children 2<sup>nd</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> grade)

This plan is based on the 3 year Sunday School rotation curriculum, focusing on reinforcing stories your child will learn in Sunday School. This plan can be read by the student alone or parents can read along with them.
