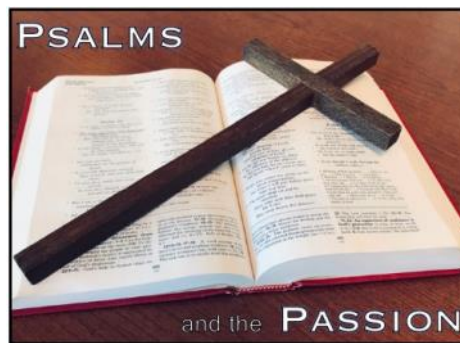
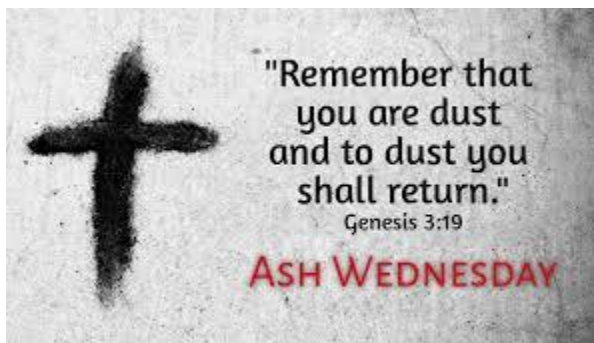
In the Community
