Pizzas will be for sale after church March 10 and 17. This is a great way to have a quick and easy dinner and support the mission trip to Blackfeet, Montana at the same time!



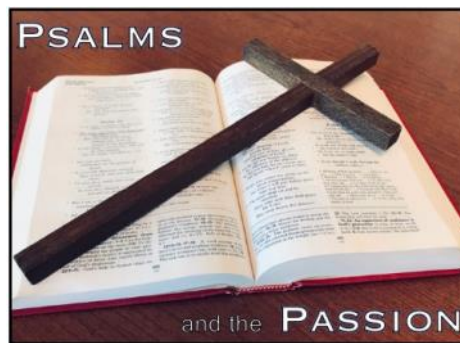
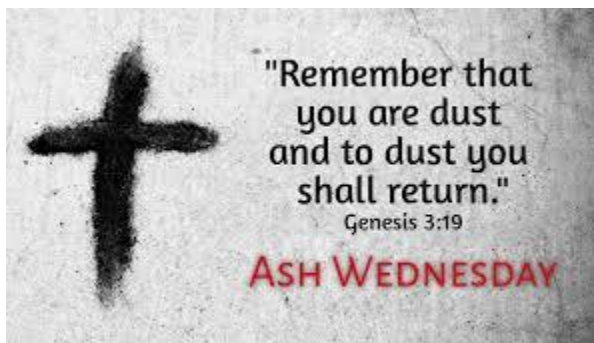
