### 56er's

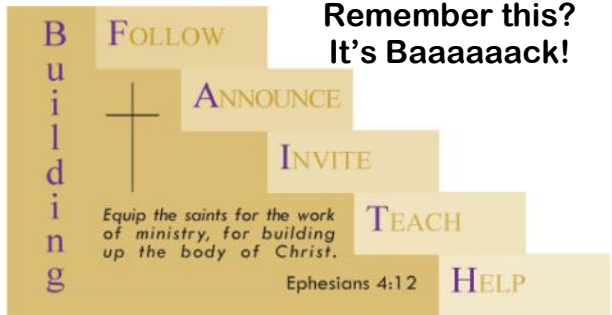
