A Digging Deeper class for parents that will look at seven changes we could make in our parenting. This is a class full of laughs, support and practical advice. Meeting in the third floor conference room.

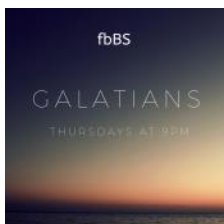


Engaging the Epistles: The Letters of St. Paul

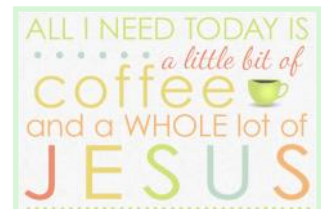

This meal will feature chili, chicken noodle soup, and grilled cheese sandwiches. What a wonderful, warm, fall meal. *All are welcome!*



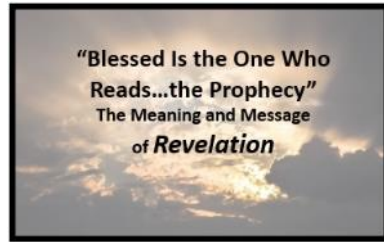
Progressive Dinner

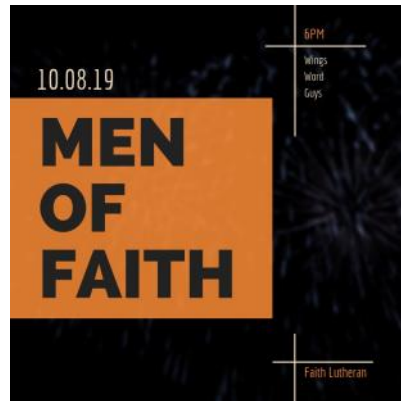
The New Faith Group

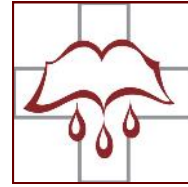
Men of Faith

Each fall, Faith Lutheran supports Global Health Ministries by collecting items needed for hospice and newborn kits. These kits are sent to medical clinics located in various countries in Africa. The following items are needed to complete newborn and hospice kits for fall delivery: 11 small jars or tubes of petroleum jelly, 3 pick combs, 4 toothbrushes, 22 nail clippers, 46 bath towels (may be gently used), 2 washcloths, 198 bandages, 6 newborn stocking caps, 36 pairs of household gloves. Thank you for your help in supporting this vital ministry that means so much to the recipients of these kits.
