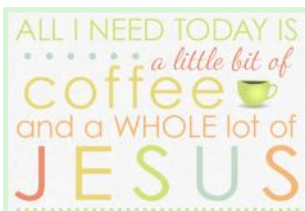

Tickets are now available for the Valentine's Dinner which will be held on Sun., Feb. 16, beginning at 5 p.m.

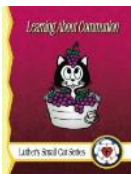
