Faith Facts



The name of the Danish flag is Dannebrog; this probably means "the cloth of the Danes". The Danish flag is red with a white Scandinavian cross that extends to the edges of the flag. The white cross represents Christianity. The white cross is also used by the other Nordic countries of Finland, Norway, Sweden, and Iceland. Moreover, the white color symbolizes peace and honesty. The red color symbolizes strength, bravery, and hardiness.
