

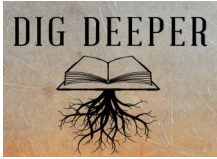

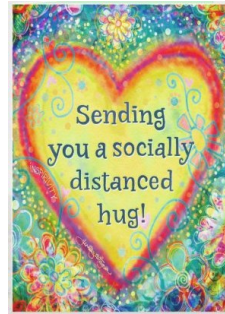


Faith Singers return!
