

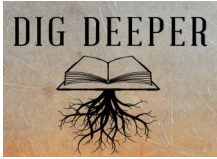

Biblical Themes for Understanding the Crucifixion

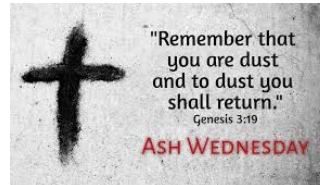
