Important Notes Regarding Covid-19 Pandemic Restrictions

- 1) First, and most importantly, if you, anyone in your family, or anyone you have recently spent time with, has Covid-like symptoms or has been diagnosed with the Covid virus, please stay home and participate via our on-line offerings.
- 2) When in the building, we ask that everyone (with the exceptions of those under age 5 or with medical reasons that preclude it) to wear a mask when around other people.
- 3) Please be aware of those around you and maintain respectful social distance from one another of 6 feet or more when moving in the hallways and when choosing where to sit for worship.
- 4) The nursery will not be staffed at this time, but the nursery and Foundation cry rooms are available for parents to use with their children. Please pick up and wash off spaces and items used when you are finished.

Overflow Seating

For the 8 a.m. First Word service, there is overflow seating in the back narthex area and in the Faith Center. Remember that the balcony is also an option for those who can navigate the stairs.

For the 10:10 a.m. Sanctuary service, there will be overflow seating in the back narthex area and the balcony.

For the Foundation service, there will be overflow seating in the Faith Center.
