Looking Back

On September 23, 1984, the congregation voted to remodel and upgrade its building to make it more accessible and energy efficient. Additional parking was made available with the purchase of all the land on Hassan Street from 3rd to 4th Avenues. A new major entrance was added to the east side of the church with an elevator. An area over the kitchen was created to be used as a chapel, with the capacity for three individual rooms. Soundproof dividers were installed in the south basement to create twelve classrooms and new restrooms were added. Air conditioning was installed in the sanctuary. The building was tuck-pointed and re-roofed. The existing west entrance to the parish building was closed off in order to provide a new secretary's office, while a double-glass enclosed door was added to the Main Street entrance. Total cost of the project was \$450,000. Groundbreaking took place on March 12, 1985, with dedication on November 10, 1985. - Martin Luther's 502nd birthday!
