- ◆ In Matthew 7:7, Jesus promised, “Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened for you.”

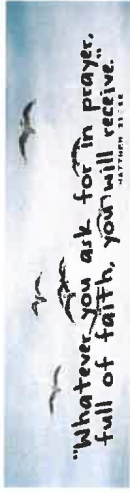
