Nicene Creed

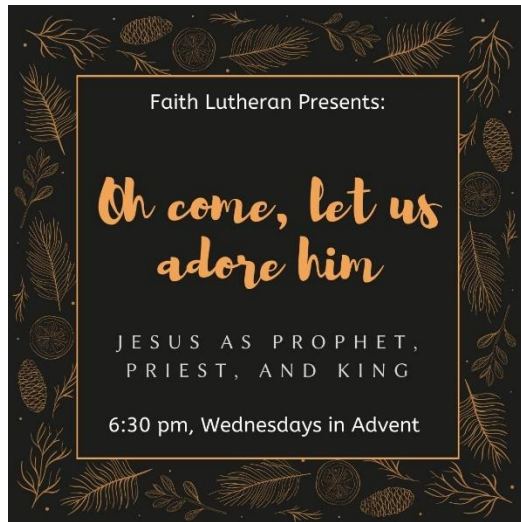
