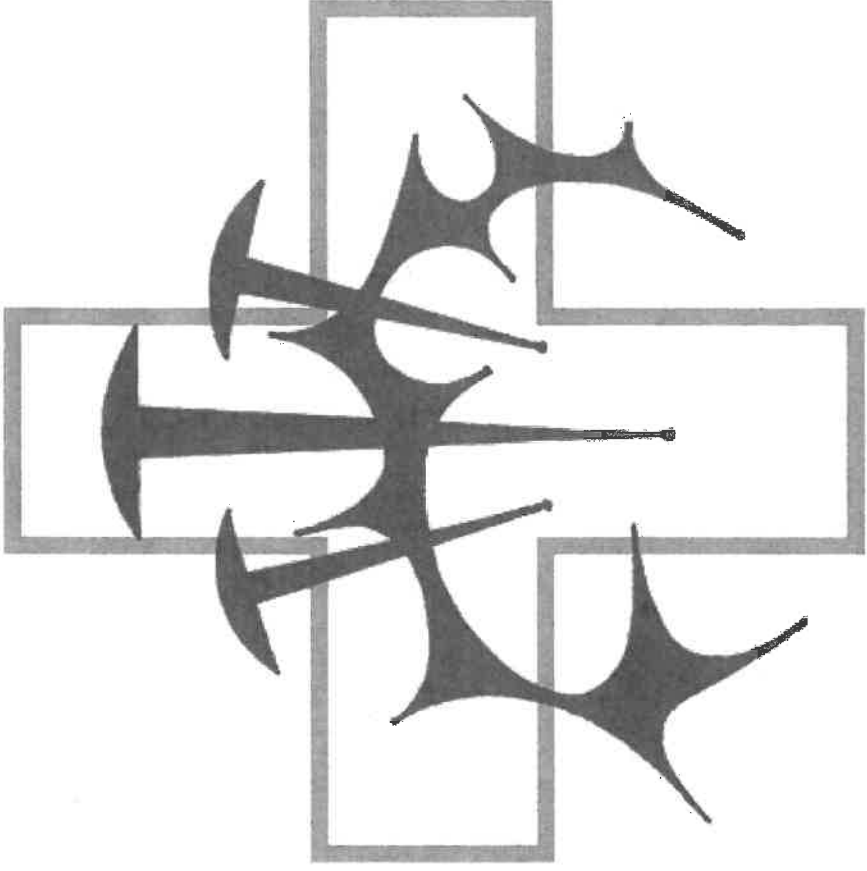


## **Easter Sunday Services**

*At the conclusion of the service you are invited to come forward and pound a nail into the cross. This is a symbolic act that connects our sins to Christ’s crucifixion and death. Jesus bore our sins upon that cross. The hymnist asked the question, “Were you there when they crucified my Lord?” We respond, “Yes!” And with a nail and a hammer we acknowledge that our sins were crucified along with Christ - “For our sake God made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.” II Corinthians 5.21*
