The radio broadcast today was sponsored by John and Shari Dorival in honor of their 35th wedding anniversary.

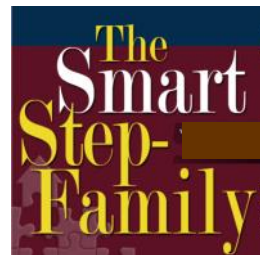
“This is the Message: Light, Life, and Love in 1 John”
