What is B23?

B23 stands for birth to three years old. This is a Sunday morning group that meets once a month for parents and their children who are not yet in Sunday School.

The class begins with a short lesson for the children and then, as the children transition into playing in the nursery, the parents have small group discussion. Some discussions have included: what we model to our children, storms in our lives, being near Jesus, thankfulness, grace, involving children in worship, Christmas, and much more.

B23 is a great way for children to feel comfortable in a Sunday School setting, which helps with the transition into Sunday School as a pre-schooler.
