



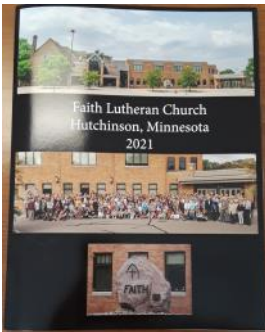

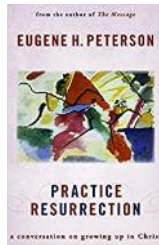


**New Faith Groups
