Proposed Amendment to the Employee Handbook

Performance Evaluations

Evaluations will be completed by the staff's direct supervisor

A time of employee feedback will be held with the personnel committee once a year

Proposed Addition to the Employee Handbook

Maternity/Paternity leave policy

6 weeks of paid maternity following a normal delivery and 8 weeks of paid maternity leave following a cesarean section birth of an employee's child.

2 weeks of paid leave will be provided for paternity or placement of a child with an employee in connection with adoption.

Up until this point this specific policy has not been in place

# Staff Compensation:

Health Plan: Only one health plan is offered through LCMC.

Plan offers:
