Our goal for the year is to pass well beyond our minimum annual goal of \$5,000. We are trusting that, moved by the Spirit, we can **double that amount.** The funds raised will be used to support three FLC Missions. The first 45% will be shared locally through Common Cup Ministries. Bey Bonte, the long time director, recently shared the challenges they face meeting increasing needs. International partners will receive 55% of the offerings: 35% to the Bishara Center in India through New Hope Mission Society and 20% through Friends Of Madagascar Mission.

Faith Financials

For the first time in several years, offerings given to Faith Lutheran have fallen well short of our budgeted expenses. The difference was especially wide in August and September. Since then, giving has risen again, but the church still faces a large deficit in the General Fund.

Between now and the end of the 2022, Faith needs to receive *a little more than \$200,000* in offerings to break even on the year. That is a very large amount, to be sure, but it is similar to the deficits the church faced back in 2018 and before. Please pray about how God has blessed you to be a blessing and give as you are able to do so in these last weeks of the year to maintain the financial health of our church. *Thank You!*
