# **November Is Mission / Hunger Appeal Month at FLC**

Our goal for the year is to pass well beyond our minimum annual amount of \$5,000. We are trusting that, moved by the Spirit, we can **double that amount**. The funds raised will be used to support three FLC Missions. The first 45% will be shared locally through Common Cup Ministries. Bev Bonte, the long time director, recently shared the challenges they face meeting increasing needs. International partners will receive 55% of the offerings: 35% to the Bishara Center in India through New Hope Mission Society and 20% through Friends Of Madagascar Mission.

Gifts for the *Hunger Appeal* can be given through offering envelopes marked *Hunger Appeal*, on Thanksgiving, or any time in November.

In the last two weeks, the family of Faith has responded very generously to help reduce the large deficit that opened up in the General Fund this year. Currently, the amount needed for the church to break even in 2022 has dropped to about \$189,000. As we noted last week, that is still a very large amount, but it is similar to the deficits the church commonly faced and overcame several years ago. 
**Snow Birds:** If it is time for you to head south for the winter, don't forget to update the church with your winter address.
