Dr. Jim Nestingen, who died suddenly last new Year’s Eve, was a brilliant and beloved teacher who trained a generation of Lutheran pastors and also taught many groups of laypeople. He had a particular gift for teaching Martin Luther’s *Small Catechism*. Many years ago, he was recorded as he taught the catechism in a congregation in the Twin Cities.
