Thursday


Why do you think we read our Bible over and over again? Or learn the same Bible story a few times throughout all of Sunday School?




An Additional Way to Dig Into the Fall Theme is to Join the Weekly Lectionary Study

A Simple Way:

Treasuring Luther's Small Catechism



Beginning today, Pastors Scott and Dave will begin a preaching series on Luther's Small Catechism. This series will dovetail with what the Sunday school and confirmation students are learning this fall. Each week will focus on a different part of the catechism: The Commandments, The Creed, The Lord's Prayer, Holy Baptism, The Office of the Keys, and the Lord's Supper. Let's all learn together the importance of this foundational Lutheran writing. The bulletins will include discussion questions for families that will allow you to dig deeper into the weekly topic at home with one another.

Crossways

A "big-picture" survey of the whole Bible



A new year-one *Crossways* class will begin on **Monday**, **Sept. 18** at **6:30 p.m.** *Crossways* is a "big picture" study of the entire Bible. It includes an overview of each book, placed within the framework of the Bible's "big story." It combines Bible reading, commentary and full-color illustrations to show how the whole Bible fits together.

Each *Crossways* class meets for 20 weeks per year (10 weeks in the fall and 10 weeks in the winter) for three years. The full-color, full-text material can be purchased for \$20/unit (a total of \$120 over three years) or the entire set at once for \$100.00. There are also several used sets of material available that can be borrowed.


