- * What is the second or “bad” way that God’s Law functions on us?
- * What is the ultimate (and *only*) solution to the Law for sinners like us?

A Simple Way: *The Ten Commandments*

Week 2 Devotional Questions for Discussion at Home

Monday

- ◆ **Adults:** Read the first Commandment is Luther’s explanation. What is the decision God has made about you? Why do we so often resist that decision?
- ◆ **Families with Youth:** What kinds of things define us these days? How does God’s declaration to be your God define you?
- ◆ **Families with Young Children:** What does it mean to be the only one?

Tuesday

- ◆ **Adults:** Luther’s Ten Commandments explanations begin with “we should fear and love God.” What does it mean to fear the Lord?
- ◆ **Families with Youth:** What authority figures do you respect? How do you treat them? What do you think it means to fear the Lord?
- ◆ **Families with Young Children:** What does respect mean? Who do you respect? How do you show respect?

Wednesday

- ◆ **Adults:** One of the functions of the Commandments is to provide order and protection. How does each Commandment accomplish this?
- ◆ **Families with Youth:** How do your parent’s rules protect you? How do the Commandments function in the same way?
- ◆ **Families with Young Children:** What kind of rules do you have at home or at school to protect everyone there?

Thursday

- ◆ **Adults:** The other function of the Commandments is to convict us, which drives us to Christ. How do the Commandments and their meanings convict you?
- ◆ **Families with Youth:** How do the Commandments show us our need for a savior?
- ◆ **Families with Young Children:** What are ways we can be kind to people? Why is it important to be kind? Should we tell others how to be kind if they are being mean?

Friday

- ◆ **Adults:** How does the First Commandment summarize all of the Commandments?
- ◆ **Families with Youth:** What do you fear, love, and trust other than God?
- ◆ **Families with Young Children:** If God gave us one rule to follow, what do you think it would be? Why?
