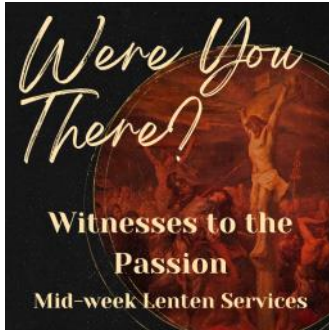
## March Free Community Meal
