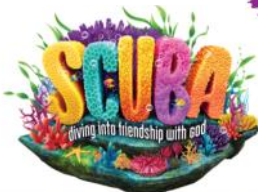
The main tasks are to deadhead the hydrangeas and to remove the seedling saplings that don't belong.

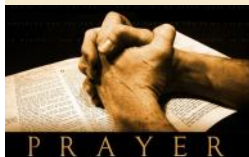


Church Cookbook
