

## Monday Morning Bible Study <u>The Story of Israel's Origins</u>

*The Story of Israel's Origins*, a study of the book of Exodus, will meet **on Mondays from 10:30 a.m. until noon, starting on September 9**. This class will build on last year's study of Genesis, *The Origins Story*, as Exodus relates how God's saving will led to forming the people of Israel into a nation, a divine process which foreshadowed the Gospel in intriguing ways.

### **Crossways Bible Study**

A new year-one *Crossways* Bible study will begin in September. *Crossways* is a "big picture" study of the entire Bible. 
## <u>Morning Mattins and</u> <u>Morning Prayer</u>
