

Litany for Reformation Sunday

Martin Luther considered his Small Catechism to be one of his most valuable works and Lutherans through the ages have concurred. It remains an invaluable explanation of the theological heart of Christian faith. Each part of this litany reflects one of the five chief parts of the catechism: the Ten Commandments, Apostles' Creed, The Lord's Prayer and the sacraments of Holy Baptism and Holy Communion.

"What Does It Mean?" Erhalt uns Herr

What does it mean that God's good will, Once thundered down from Sinai's hill, Is uttered now to pierce our hearts, Commandments that our God imparts?

L: The days are surely coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah. What does it mean – what doubts relieve – That we may speak what we believe And in confessing witness bear To Father, Savior, Comforter?

L: This is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put my Law within them, and will write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they shall be my people.
