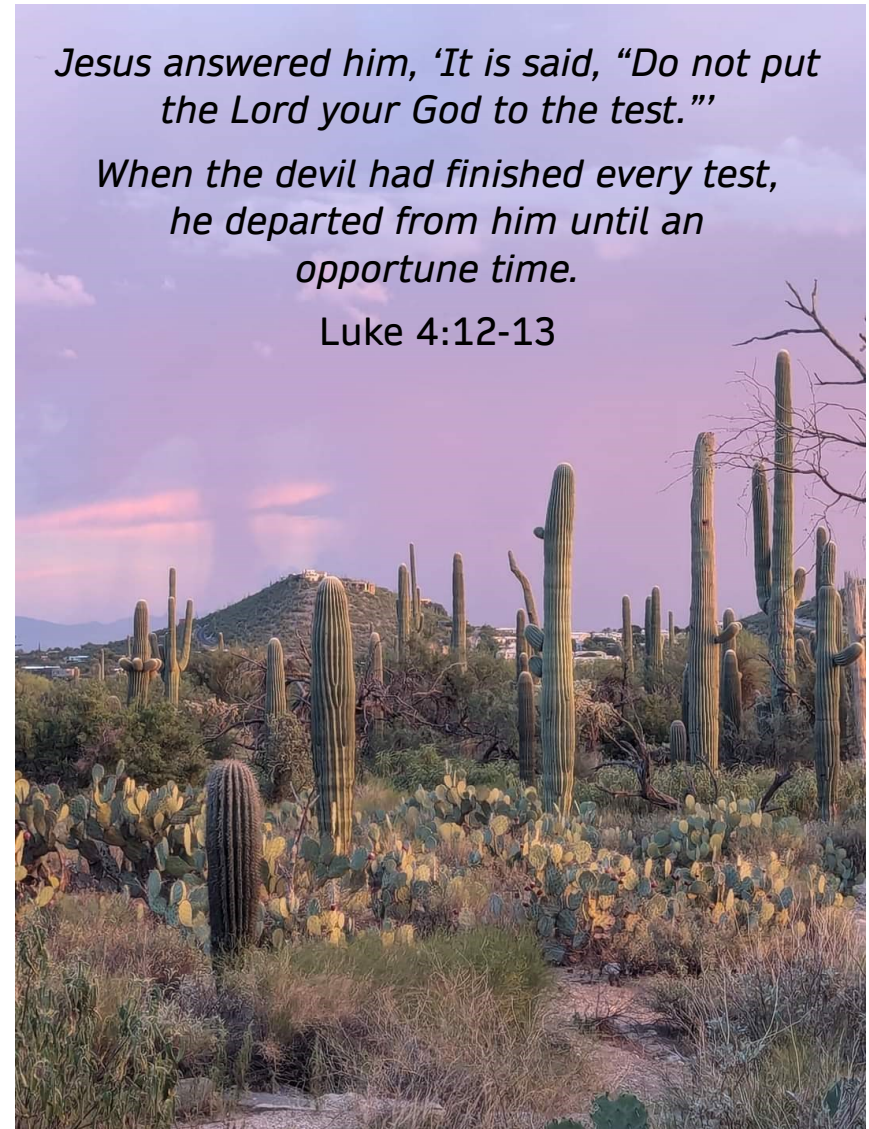
What Does This Mean?
