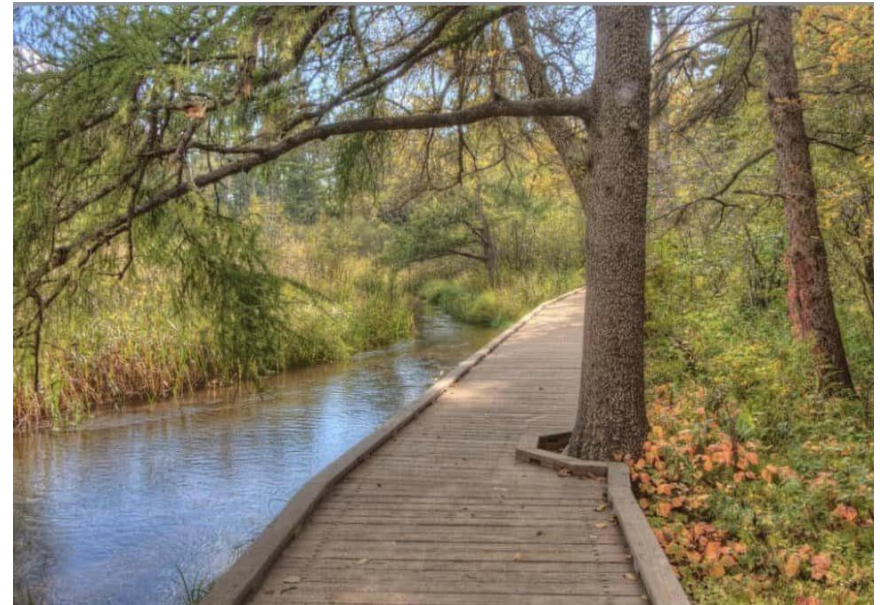
What Does This Mean?

Nicene Creed

**We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of
