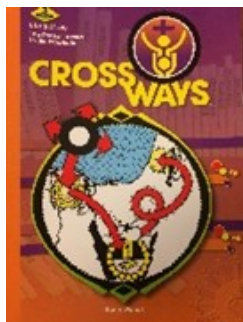
Continuing Learning Opportunities for Adults
